CV of H.E. Mr. Dae Jong YOO, Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to the Republic of Serbia

Prior to his appointment as Ambassador of the Republic of Korea to the Republic of Serbia, Ambassador Yoo was Director-General for International Organizations (from October 2014 to September 2016) at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea. He was responsible for UN policy, disarmament and non-proliferation issues, human rights and social affairs, as well as for international security, such as OSCE, NATO and Cyber Space.

After joining the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Korea in 1988, Mr. Yoo worked in the China Division, West European Division, and the Office of the Vice Minister of Foreign Affairs. He also served as Director of Personnel Division (2003-2004) and United Nations Division (2007-2008).

In 2009, he was seconded to the task force for launching the ASEAN – Korea Centre in Seoul. After the establishment of the Centre, he worked as Director of Development Planning and General Affairs of the Centre.

As for overseas postings, he was assigned to the Permanent Mission of Korea to the International Organizations in Geneva (1997-1999), where he was responsible for human rights, humanitarian assistance, and trade issues. He was also posted to the Embassy in Senegal (2000-2001) and the Permanent Mission of Korea to the United Nations in New York (2004-2006) in charge of UN management and reform issues.

From 2010 to 2012, he worked as Minister Counselor at the Permanent Mission of Korea to the International Organizations in Vienna, Austria. He was in charge of disarmament and non-proliferation issues, development and energy issues, OSCE, as well as of Slovenia.

In February 2012, he was posted to the Korean Mission to the UN in New York as Minister Counsellor responsible for coordinating the General Assembly and Security Council work. He was a member of the UN Committee on Contributions (CoC) for the terms of 2012-2014.

Mr. Yoo, born in 1963, holds a B.A. degree in French literature and international relations at Seoul National University. He studied at the École Nationale d'Administration (ENA) (Promotion René Char, 1993-94) in France, and was a visiting scholar at the University of California San Diego in the U.S. He is married with two sons.
