

A Brief History (1)

The Power of Heritage and Tradition: Historical Milestones

Toward the Establishment of the University of Novi Sad

1740

The foundations of higher education in today's Autonomous Province of Vojvodina, and Serbia as a whole, were laid with the establishment of the seminary

Collegium Vissariono - Pawlovicsianum Petrovaradinense in Novi Sad

.... 1778

Norma - School for the education of Serbian teachers was founded in Sombor. The School is considered to be one of the predecessors of today's Faculty of Education in Sombor, University of Novi Sad

1812

Establishment of *Preparandija* – a Serbian teachers' college. The School was founded in Szentendre and its seat was moved to Sombor in 1816. The School is also considered to be one of the predecessors of today's Faculty of Education in Sombor, University of Novi Sad

1826

Establishment of *Matica Srpska*, the oldest cultural and scientific institution of the Serbian people, which played a significant role in the development of scientific thought from the 19th century onwards. It was founded in 1826 in Pest and moved its seat to Novi Sad in 1864

1920

The Faculty of Law in Subotica was founded as a member of the University of Belgrade. In its 20-year existence, the Faculty made a special contribution to the development of legal science and education in Vojvodina

... 1954

The first faculties of the future University of Novi Sad were established as members of the University of Belgrade: **Faculty of Philosophy** and **Faculty of Agriculture**, with the first generation of students that counted about 500. The first lectures started at the Faculty of Agriculture in November and at the Faculty of Philosophy in December.

Historical Milestones in the Development of the

University of Novi Sad

1960

On June 28th, National Assembly of Serbia adopted the Law on Establishment of the University of Novi Sad, consisting of the previously founded faculties (1954-1960): of Philosophy, Agriculture, Law, Technology, Medicine, Mechanical Engineering - in Novi Sad, and the Faculty of Economics - in Subotica

1960

In September, the first University Assembly was held and the first University leadership was elected - Rector Prof. Dr. Lazar Stojković, and Vice-Rector Prof. Dr. Boško Novaković

1969

Establishment of the Faculty of Sciences

1974

Establishment of the Academy of Arts in Novi Sad, Faculty of Civil Engineering in Subotica, Faculty of Pedagogy and **Technology** in Zrenjanin (today: Technical Faculty "Mihajlo Pupin") and the Faculty of **Physical Education** in Novi Sad (today: Faculty of Sport and Physical Education)

1992

Beginning of the **University** interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary studies and research center (the first program: in 1992/1993 within the Tempus center in the field of Environmental Engineering)

1993

Establishment of the **Teacher Training Faculty** in Sombor (today: Faculty of Education)

2006

Establishment of the **Hungarian** Language Teacher Training Faculty in Subotica

Establishment of today's Institute of Food Technology

2007

Today's Institute of Lowland Forestry and Environment and Institute of Food Technology in Novi Sad officially became members of UNS

2015

Establishment of the **BioSense Institute** - Research and Development Institute for Information Technologies of Biosystems

The BioSense Institute officially became a member of the University of Novi Sad















University Today

- One of the largest educational and scientific centers in Central Europe, with almost 50,000 students and more than 5,000 members of staff.
- Internationally recognized **among the top 1,000 universities in the world** (among the first 300 world leading universities in the fields of Food Science & Technology, Hospitality & Tourism Management, Agriculture and Forestry).
- Second largest university in Serbia and the only state university in the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina.
- **University Campus** a unique feature, located on the banks of the River Danube, in the vicinity of the historical city center.






- All levels of study: undergraduate (40%), master & specialist (42%) and doctoral (18%)
- Study programmes in 2023/2024: **328**




-> **Total number of staff** at faculties, institutes and central university level in 2023/2024



The strength of the University of Novi Sad lies in the developed scientific infrastructure with about 250 laboratories, strong innovative potential, rich library fund, as well as in several nationally accredited centers of excellence.

BioSense Institute -Leaders in IT of Biosystems

A pioneer in digital transformation of agriculture in Serbia, founded in 2015. By exploring the scientific and technological frontiers in the application of IT in agriculture, the Institute strives to deliver state-of-the-art digital solutions to the farming sector in Serbia and the world, in order to ensure higher yields with smaller investments.
