LANGUAGE AND SOCIAL SCIENCES IN CONTACT: ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE (AI)

on October 3, 2026, at the Faculty of Philosophy in Novi Sad

Following the successful conference *Language and Social Sciences in Contact: Remembrance Culture*, the Centre for Interdisciplinary Research and Researcher Development at the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad, is organizing this year's scientific conference on the topic of artificial intelligence. The aim of the conference is to foster an interdisciplinary dialogue on the impact of artificial intelligence on language, communication, and social practice, as well as on the role of the social sciences and humanities in understanding and shaping contemporary AI technologies. The conference is open to researchers in **the fields of social sciences and humanities, as well as to AI experts interested in humanities and social perspectives**.

We welcome presentations addressing the following areas and subfields:

- **Linguistics and AI** (Corpus/Computational Linguistics; Natural Language Processing; Analysis of Large Language Models; Forensic Linguistics and Stylometry in the Age of AI)
- **Literature and AI** (Creative Writing and AI; AI and Literary Criticism; Artificial Intelligence and Genre Literature)

- **Sociology and AI** (Digital Sociology; Sociology of Communication; Sociology of Technology)
- **History and AI** (History of AI Development; AI as a Tool in Academic Research and History Teaching)
- **Archaeology and AI** (Detection of Archaeological Sites and AI; Predictive Archaeology)
- **Geography and AI** (Geographic Information Systems and AI; Remote Sensing and Satellite Data)
- **Philosophy and AI** (Ethics of AI; Ontology and the Status of AI)
- **Psychology and AI** (Cognitive Psychology and AI; AI as a Tool in Psychology and Psychotherapy)
- **Pedagogy and AI** (AI and the Teaching Methodology; Contemporary Teaching Models and AI; Implications of Students' Use of AI)
- **Journalism and AI** (Automated Journalism; Disinformation and Deepfake Technology)

We kindly invite you to submit an abstract of your presentation addressing one of the above-mentioned areas or related subfields. Proposals beyond these areas will also be considered.

The conference will be held **in person** at the premises of the Faculty of Philosophy, University of Novi Sad.

The working languages of the conference are **English and Serbian**, while **the abstract must be submitted in English**. Each presentation is allotted **20 minutes**. The participation fee for the conference is **3,000.00 RSD per presenter**.

Instructions for Submitting Abstracts

The abstract should include the following elements:

1. full name(s) of the author(s) and co-author(s)
2. affiliation(s) of the author(s) and co-author(s)
3. e-mail address(es) of the author(s) and co-author(s)
4. ORCID ID(s) of the author(s) and co-author(s)
5. title of the presentation – up to 15 words
6. a clear description of the research objectives, methods, and results – between 180 and 250 words
7. keywords – up to 10 words
8. The abstract must be submitted in .doc or .docx format, with *Single* spacing, font 11pt *Times New Roman*, and *justified* alignment.

The abstract template with technical specifications is attached.

Abstracts in English should be submitted electronically to the conference e-mail address: **interdisciplinarnost.konf@ff.uns.ac.rs**, with the file named as **FirstName_LastName_Title of the Paper**. The submission deadline is **June 15, 2026**.

Students may submit abstracts (formatted according to the given guidelines) to be presented during the poster session.

Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent by **June 30, 2026**. The conference program and the book of abstracts will be published **by the end of September**.

Papers presented at the conference may be published in the Conference Proceedings, which will be issued in electronic format. The deadline for submitting full papers, either in **Serbian** or **English**, is **November 1, 2026**, and the proceedings will be published during 2027. The previous two volumes of the proceedings were published in **category M12** (proceedings of international scientific conferences).
